

ACWC General Committee Report, 2022/11/04

1. 2022 is the centenary of the Women's Ministry of the Presbyterian Church in Taiwan. A celebration meeting was held in Tainan on September 23-24. We regret the fact that, because of the ongoing pandemic situation, we could not invite guests from outside Taiwan to join our celebration. However, we welcome ACWC can come to Taiwan next year for ACWC Assembly.
2. 2023 World Day of Prayer Taiwan. We have printed a calendar to promote WDP. The relationship between Taiwan and China is becoming increasingly tense. We call on fellow Christians to pray for a democratic and free Taiwan, and also for world peace.
3. Circle of Prayer by The Fellowship of the Least Coin (FLC) has been translated into Chinese and published in the Lusoan Magazine. The support project has also been translated into Chinese to promote the FLC movement. We also keep promoting the Chinese version of Shanti Means Peace, the children's picture book of FLC.
4. To support the Thursdays In Black Campaign and the prevention of gender-based violence, we wear black clothes every Thursday. When we hold events on Thursday, we also dress in black to express our stand against gender-based violence.
